How to purchase breeding materials and Poultry chicks

The farmer who is interested to purchase breeding materials or chicks from NLDB, the following requirements to be fulfilled.

- a) To purchase Cattle, Goat and Sheep, the farmer should forward a letter of request for breeding materials from the General Manager of National Livestock Development Board with the recommendation of the area veterinary Surgeon.
 - Pigs can be purchased directly by contacting the respective manager of the farm.
- b) Request letters should be forwarded minimum of 3 weeks prior to the date expected to purchase breeding materials.
- c) All requests except for pigs and chicks will be registered in the Head Office and a reply letter will be sent to the farmer within 3 days from receiving the request, mentioning his registration number.
- d) The farmer will be informed and directed to purchase the required breeding materials within 2 Months according to first come first serve basis.
- e) The breeding materials will be issued to the farmer from a selected farm at the rates given in the Livestock sales circular of the Board.
- f) To purchase day old pullets and broilers, it is required to keep a deposit (as a bond) in the respective hatchery and there after the farmer can purchase the required quantity when needed.
